

Automatic Number Plate Recognition (ANPR) for School Vehicle Management



The John Hampden Grammar School was established as the Schools of Science and Art to provide an outstanding education, for young people, near High Wycombe. To achieve part of this objective, the school required a modern CCTV system with Automatic License Plate Recognition (ANPR) and they chose Prime Digital to deliver this system.
